

Intent:

What are we trying to achieve through our curriculum?

At Allerton Bywater Primary School, we design and deliver a diverse, ambitious curriculum which will meet the needs of all our learners. The learning journeys are inspired by the children's interests and are delivered through a fluid, cross-curricular approach. We ensure that learning is engaging, exciting and innovative whilst also developing the knowledge, skills and understanding necessary to prepare all our learners for their academic, vocational and technical futures.

Implementation:

How we deliver our curriculum?

We implement our curriculum through the use of half-termly topics which are designed to complement and build on one another across each year group. In order to engage and excite the children in their learning, each topic is launched through a focused enrichment day. Our topics are constructed with clear progression and links so that in subsequent years our learners will be able to explore concepts deeper and apply their knowledge in different contexts. These topics are underpinned by the objectives contained within the framework of the National Curriculum. When necessary, topics are supplemented by discrete lessons to ensure full coverage of the National Curriculum.
