  - Music outside (we have this in summer but council feel it should be all year)
  - Climbing frame with swings
  - Wooden play houses and tents on field
  - Bike and scooter area with track
  - More lunchtime discos
  - Chalking area
  - More areas for lessons outside and outdoor classrooms
- These are some brilliant ideas and we have discussed that some will be too expensive and some may be a safety risk so we will decide at the next meeting what we can make happen first.
